Don't forget our Annual General Meeting being held today, March 1st following a light lunch after the morning service.

Our regular Presbytery Visitation (usually once every 3years) will be held on **Tuesday, March 10th** at the Church. The General Presbyter along with some Presbytery members will meet with the Minister, Session, Board and any interested members to assess the health and well-being of our congregation. The meeting schedule is:

7:30 PM - meet with the Board

8:00 PM - meet with members of the congregation

The Session has confirmed its understanding of marriage as a covenant relationship between a man and a woman which is the traditional viewpoint regarding marriage.

We are also looking to put together a team of elders, board members and congregants as an action and stewardship group to address issues such as communication, stewardship and cohesiveness.
