Aboriginal Awareness Event - May 25 2019

St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church is cohosting with the Aboriginal Friendship Centre an "Aboriginal Awareness" event on the afternoon of 25 May 2019. Our broad objective is to extend and expand mutual understanding and acceptance within our respective communities. Our immediate objective on that day is to offer Calgary citizens an opportunity to join us for an afternoon of education, experience, and fun for all ages. You're all invited!

The opening ceremony will take place at 1:30 PM in front of two tipis, and with the flags of Canada, local First Nations and Metis flying. Educational activities by volunteers from First Nations will include art classes, bead work, and native dancing, sometimes with audience participation. Local aboriginal vendors will be on site, drumming and dancing will take place throughout the event, and a bison feast will conclude the day. There is no charge for your attendance!

St. Andrews is at 703 Heritage Drive SW, 500 m west of the C-train Heritage Station.

The Session has resolved to add up to 4 new elders who will have six year terms. A letter will be going out in mid-March with the information on the process.
