WHAT TO EXPECT

- ♦ There will be no Church School or nursery for the month of August.
- ♦ Children are asked to remain in their seats for Children's Time.
- ◆ There will be no bulletins, so please pay attention to the announcements that will be shown on the screens before the service.
- ◆ Please, if you are experiencing symptoms of any illness do not come to church
